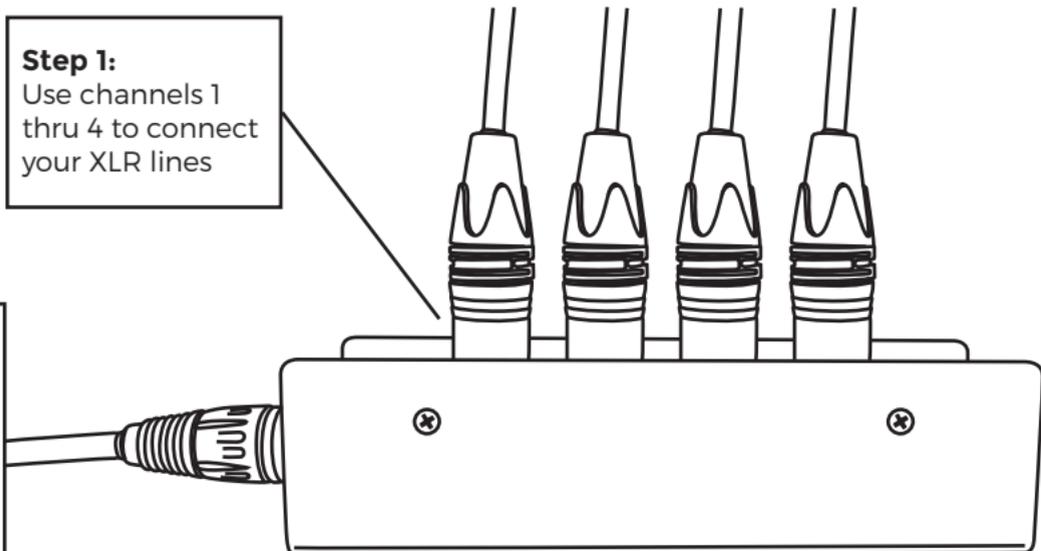


# CAT BOX FX STARTER GUIDE

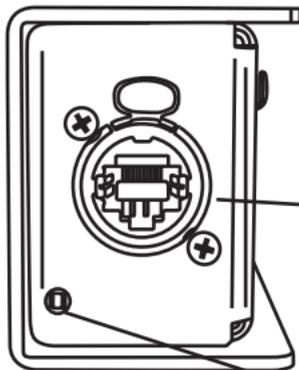
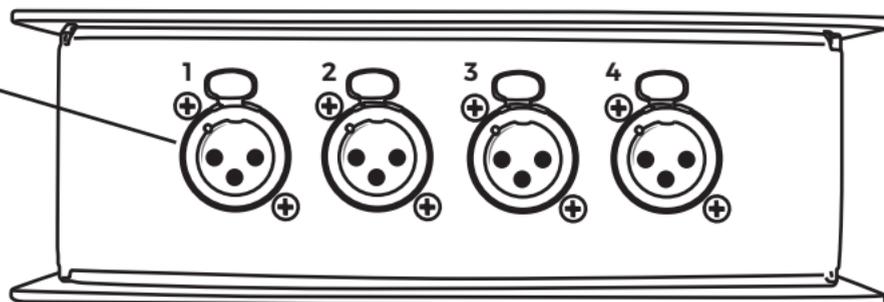
**Step 1:**  
Use channels 1  
thru 4 to connect  
your XLR lines

**Step 2:**  
Insert a shielded CAT5e  
cable into either etherCON  
receptacle and connect the  
other end of the cable to an  
additional CAT box, CAT Tails  
or other SoundTools RATCAT  
unit.



#### 4 Female XLR connectors

You can run different types of signals simultaneously over the same shielded CAT5e cable. The most common types of signals include analog audio, AES3, DMX and COM and COM



#### etherCON IN/OUT and THRU

Using shielded CAT5e cable will minimize noise and interference and is required when using phantom power. For some applications, such as AES3, unshielded CAT5e cable can be utilized.

The CAT Box features two etherCON connectors. (IN/OUT and Thru) This allows multiple CAT Box units to daisy chain the same four channels to multiple locations and utilize the CAT Box as a splitter.

#### Chasis Ground Switch

Located on one end, the ground lift switch disconnects the cable shield from the chasis of the box. This can be useful if the metal housing of the box comes into contact with something that may cause interference.
